


Montpelier Station to Gloucester Road Library

A walk from Montpelier Station (Severn Beach line) to the new library and Medical Centre in Gloucester Road, avoiding the busy main road but with steps and steeply sloping pavements in places. Unsuitable for pushchairs and wheelchairs.

Distance: 0.8 miles / 1.2 km
Allow: About 25 minutes
Suitability: Easy for walkers.



- 1. START:** Montpelier Station. Turn left and take the 20 step steps up to the footbridge.
- 2.** Turn left onto and over the footbridge, climbing another set of 22 step steps up onto the paved path which continues steeply to Cromwell Road.
- 3.** Turn right onto Cromwell Road (n.b. busy traffic) and cross diagonally right over Cromwell Road, keeping right.
- 4.** Almost immediately turn sharp left steeply uphill into Belvoir Road, crossing over diagonally left to other side.
- 5.** Almost immediately turn right into Chesterfield Avenue and follow it to its end where it meets Chesterfield Road.
- 6.** Turn left into Chesterfield Road, keeping on its left hand side and follow it to its end with the junction with Effingham Road.
- 7.** Cross over onto the other side of Chesterfield Road, and turn right into Effingham Road, keeping on its right hand side.

- 8.** On reaching No. 10 Effingham Road, cross over into David Thomas Lane directly opposite. Walk down this lane until it ends on Belmont Road.
- 9.** Turn right into Belmont Road, and follow it to the junction with Grenville Road.
- 10.** Turn left into Grenville Road and walk the short stretch until it ends with the junction with North Road.
- 11.** Turn right into North Road and cross diagonally right over to its left side. Continue to No 94 and an old lamp post.
- 12.** Turn left here into Bolton Road (which is a lane rather than a road) and walk to its end.
- 13.** You are now on Gloucester Road. Turn right here and almost immediately cross Gloucester Road at traffic lights with a pedestrian crossing.
- 14.** Turn left here and walk to the Health Centre and Library, 100 metres along the road.
